Yes. I worked for Dept of human services. We administered many of the flint water crisis benefits. They treated flint residents so poorly and disrespectfully, many people would go without benefits than deal with the workers. One huge reason for this is because Lansing received next to Zero complaints from our clients

They had a local policy that forced clients to leave messages with four levels of management before we could give the Lansing complaint number. Most dropped out after the first supervisor ignored their complaints. I put up a billboard in the parking lot with the phone number.

The Flint Journal did a story on it, and at the end, Bob Wheaton said that the number on my billboard was wrong, and that other number I posted was a general information hotline.

Per the attached disciplinary letter, they scrutinized everything including my use of the old MDHHS acronym. They never said the phone number was wrong, and they also

state that the same number was posted all over the office. According to their own words, we weren't even giving out the correct phone number.

That's a coverup. Yet another way to keep flint residents from complaining to Lansing where no news is good news. This is a HUGE DEAL as one would think the service would be excellent since MDHHS poisoned us all to begin with.

Please notice the comments posted at the end of the Mlive article and you'll understand completely why the office would go to such lengths to silence them. Our flint resident truly have no voice, the office has a reputation statewide for being the worst office in the entire state. I have TONS of documents and would be happy to speak with anyone.
